The M-M Trails Committee sent a \$5000 check (revenues from the sales of the M-M guide book) to the Town of Northfield which, with the State and Mt. Grace Land Trust, is purchasing a 45-acre parcel now called Brushy Mountain Conservation Area.

This is the sixth purchase in which M-M Trails Committee has participated.

Discussions concerning signage for the southern section (southernmost 12 sections) is under way with the Pioneer Valley Planning Commission.
