DRAFT Minutes of Meeting - March 24, 2008

The meeting was called to order at 6:37 P.M. Hanauer introduced the guests present. The minutes of February 25, 2008 were reviewed and, on a motion by Napolitano, seconded by Levine, the minutes were approved unanimously with revisions.
